

2013 COLLIER TOWNSHIP COLLECTION REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

1. Regular Curbside Collection: Garbage and refuse will be collected once every week. Garbage and refuse should be placed at the curb after 6 p.m. on the prior day and before 6 a.m. on the scheduled collection day.

2. Guidelines for Collection:

- Garbage should be in properly secured containers or plastic bags.
- Grass clippings and weeds should be in plastic bags.
- Hedge cuttings, limbs and branches should be securely tied and should not exceed 48 inches in length; branches should not exceed 3 inches in diameter.
- Newspapers and magazines should be securely tied in bundles
- All furniture items (1 item per week), appliances, household goods and disassembled children's swing sets will be accepted at curbside.
- Carpet should be rolled and tied in lengths not to exceed 48 inches.
- Empty paint cans and/or dried paint is acceptable. Paint can be dried by air drying or soaking up with newspaper or kitty litter. Lids should be left off.
- Christmas trees – place at the curb for pickup during the months December, January, & February

3. Excluded Items:

- Building materials (may be picked up for a fee by calling Republic Services at: **412-429-2600**)
- Automobile parts including wheel rims.
- Trees and branches over 3 inches in diameter.
- Ashes from furnaces and fireplaces.
- Stones, dirt, & leaves (municipality provides compost pickup)
- Tires
- Liquid paint
- Desktop and Laptop computers including monitors and computer peripherals
- Televisions

4. Recycling: Place all of your recyclable materials in one container PROVIDED TO YOU BY Republic Services...no separating or sorting needed. We'll do it for you! **Recycle all of these items in your Single Sort Recycle Container:** Glass bottles & jars, metal beverage & food cans, plastic bottles with narrow necks, newspaper, magazines, junk mail, dry non-coated food paper, boxboard, small flat pieces of corrugated cardboard. (All cardboard must be broken down so it is flat & no more than 3 feet in length or width & tied in a bundle). Please place the materials listed above together (loosely mixed in your recycle container).

These items can't be recycled. Please put them in your trash:

Garbage, food waste, diapers, paper plates, meat or dairy plastic or paper packaging, wax paper, plastic wrap, plastic bags, plastic wrapping film, freezer food packaging, plastic deli take-out packaging or plastic utensils, formed or pellet styrofoam packaging, window glass, ceramics, or dishware, mirrors, light bulbs.

5. Holiday Service: If a holiday falls on a Monday through Friday, pickup for the rest of the week will be one day later than the usual day.

Observed holidays for 2013 are: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, and Thanksgiving, and Christmas Day. Your pick up day **will be one day later than your scheduled pickup day** if your pickup day falls on the observed holiday.

6. Appliances containing refrigerant: Items such as: refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, water coolers, or any other appliance containing **refrigerant** will only be picked up if the item has a sticker certifying the refrigerant has been removed. If there is no sticker certifying removal, we will not pickup the item due to laws prohibiting disposal without certification the refrigerant has been removed. It is suggested that you have the company delivering the new appliance dispose of the old appliance to save on the removal cost of the refrigerant.

The easiest way to recycle is here in Collier Township offered by Republic Services!

Residents will be receiving their blue recycling tub from Republic around December 15, 2012 and service will begin on January 1, 2013.

In January 2013, all your recyclable materials in one container with no separating or sorting needed. We'll do it for you! Just a few simple guidelines outlined below to avoid any service interruptions:

YES!

- Glass bottles and jars
- Metal beverage and food cans
- Paper milk or Juice containers
- Aluminum cans
- Egg Cartons
- Plastic bottles (Types 1 through 7)
- Paper from news, magazines, junk mail, dry non-coated food paper
- Boxboard – tissue, dryer sheets, tooth paste, cereal, spaghetti, cracker and other dry foods boxes
- All cardboard must be broken down so that it is flat and no more than 3-feet in length or width and must be inside your cart.

NO!

- Garbage, food waste, diapers, paper plates, hangers, old plastic toys
- Meat or Cheese plastic wrapping or paper packaging
- Wax or plastic wrap or bags
- Freezer food packaging
- Plastic deli, product or take-out packaging or utensils
- Plastic bags or wrapping film
- Formed or pellet styrofoam packaging
- Window glass, ceramics or dishware, mirrors, light bulbs
